Mr. Schultz welcomed everyone during the Annual General Meeting.

APPROVAL OF MAY 2022 CSPC MINUTES

PRINCIPALS REPORT – Mr. Schultz

- 100th Anniversary went really well last Saturday. Thank you to all parents, students and other volunteers for all of their work.
- Terry Fox Run went very well last week. Kids had a great day. To date raised \$2680 for the Terry Fox Foundation.
- School year is off to a great start.
- Moving to regular operation with the TCDSB. Board doesn't anticipate cancelling events or re-implementing any restrictions/closures.
- Staffing and school reorg – we will not be losing any teachers. Ms. Souza's SK/1 is becoming a straight grade 1 class, so the SKs will go back to one of the two kindergarten classes. Kindergarten classes will now be full to their caps.
- Ms. Careri is on a leave. Ms. Dupont was here initially, however Mr. Glorioso has now taken the LTO role in that class.
- Head Caretaker role still not filled. Michael DiMatteo currently filling in the caretaker role, however he does not have the qualifications to take the head caretaker role. In the meantime, Michael will be here until a new head is found. Mr. Schultz doesn't have a say in this, as this is a Board decision regarding hiring.
- We do not have a date for Curriculum Night. As far as Mr. Schultz is aware, he is awaiting to receive a go-ahead from the TCDSB. Once this is received, a date will be selected.
- No insider information regarding the secretary/custodian/teacher contract negotiations. Mr. Schultz doesn't expect to receive any information other than what's available in the media.

- School Cash Online is current at 93% participation. Great, quick uptake. Much better and lower risk for administration.
- Library – expect to move PLASP across the hall to the vacant extra classroom, so that we can create a good library in the school for classes to use. Will be working on this over the coming months. We do have a Library Technician position open at 50% of full-time capacity. Goal for this year is to get a room setup and get some furniture in it, then we will build off of it in coming years.
- Ms. Miaco thanked all of Parent Council for all of the work that we do.

CHAIR'S REPORT

- Lisa Dess to continue to do Social Justice. Calendar has been reviewed with Mr. Schultz.
- Vicki Fox, Sasha Jardine, Tanya Toscano, Ashley Galea to work with Marianne Ventrone on the Christmas Bazaar.
- 100th Anniversary:
 - Day went well. Will recap the financials at the next meeting. Huge thank you to Christine, Marianne, Mike, Lindsay, Lauren and Marcia for working on this.
 - We sold a ton of apparel on Saturday.
 - 48 pizzas sold.
- Apparel catching up. Most back orders are coming in ok now. 100th Anniversary apparel sold really well.
- Proposed initiatives for 2022/23 will be reviewed and voted-on during the October meeting.

TREASURER'S REPORT – Christine

- \$300 allocation to the teachers for fieldtrips and workshops can go ahead.
- Teachers can move forward with booking the first Scientist in the School session.
- Budget to be reviewed at October meeting. Outline will be sent in advance of CSPC meeting for review, with questions answered and vote during meeting.
- If teachers need further funding beyond what's currently in the budget, this will be reviewed later in the year.
- To date, 142/428 students paid activity fee online. Subsidy received so far of \$260.
