CSPC 2020-2021 ACCOMPLISHMENTS

CSPC ACTIVITIES

- CSPC Activity Fee fundraiser collected \$15,170.00. This represents 88% of the in-person population and 58% of the aggregate in-person and virtual student population. These funds were initially used to cover the costs of Teacher and Classroom Resources, additional air purifiers and replacement filters. Agendas were not supplied this year.
- CSPC's Social Justice organized monthly Civvies Days with funds collected going to support our chosen charities, Terry Fox Day, World Diabetes, etc. Due to COVID-19, we relaxed our usual charity rules and attempted to focus each month on a more relevant charity for the times, including the Kids Help Phone and the Indian Residential School Survivors Society.
- CSPC Spirit Committee organized fun monthly themed "Spirit" Days where students could get creative.
- CSPC's website continued to see some growth in its users and a helpful resource to our parents. We used the shopping cart more this year with additional online fundraisers, including the cookie kits and Xmas video sales.
- CSPC Twitter and FB accounts were keeping our parents and caregivers up to date with our various activities.
- We added a few new fundraising efforts in the mix due to COVID-19, which we have learned from and may continue to incorporate.
- Overall, this was a less active year in terms of large events but we conducted a lot of small things.

SEPTEMBER

- The school was moved to the School Messenger system overseen by the TCDSB and the Room Parent network was disbanded.

OCTOBER

- CSPC held its AGM on Thursday, October 15, 2020 with the nomination of 13 members to the council.
- Terry Fox Run/Walk was held October 6.
- Voted to purchase additional air purifiers and filter replacements for classrooms that do not have one.

NOVEMBER

- We elected Don Hunter as our community rep for the council.
- Additional 30 Chromebooks were purchased as a Capital cost for the school.
- Remote Navy & White exchange was run.
- Jen Janke began the food drive to support Loaves and Fishes through St. Pius X church. This effort continued throughout the year.
- Ran survey on preferred Civvies Day charities for the year of COVID, which went on to alter many of our monthly charities.

DECEMBER

- SPX Families in Need gift cards were bought and distributed.
- Xmas Crafts for in person kids was run successfully.
- Teachers and students all contributed to an amazing Xmas celebration video that was broadcast to the entire community. Copies to keep were then sold during the remainder of the year.
- Gift Card Drive with Bishop Allen also run successfully.
- Added LOB and Woodward Meats to the FlipGive and Mabels Labels fundraisers.

JANUARY

- We changed one of our civvies days charities from World Diabetes to Diabetes Canada
- Paul David online "Internet Safety" program held for parents and kids.

FEBRUARY

- First Cookie Kit run for Family Day and Valentine's Day.

MARCH

- We elected to fund online dance and drama workshops for all classes.
- Ran another Cookie Kit Drive for Easter
- Ran Moonbeam Books fundraiser

APRIL

- Held the Ann Douglas event on parenting during COVID.

MAY

- Approved purchase of 4 additional white boards for the JK/SK classes.

JUNE

- Ran an Orange Ribbon Initiative (on the school fence).
- Raised the Rainbow Flag in honour of Pride Month.
